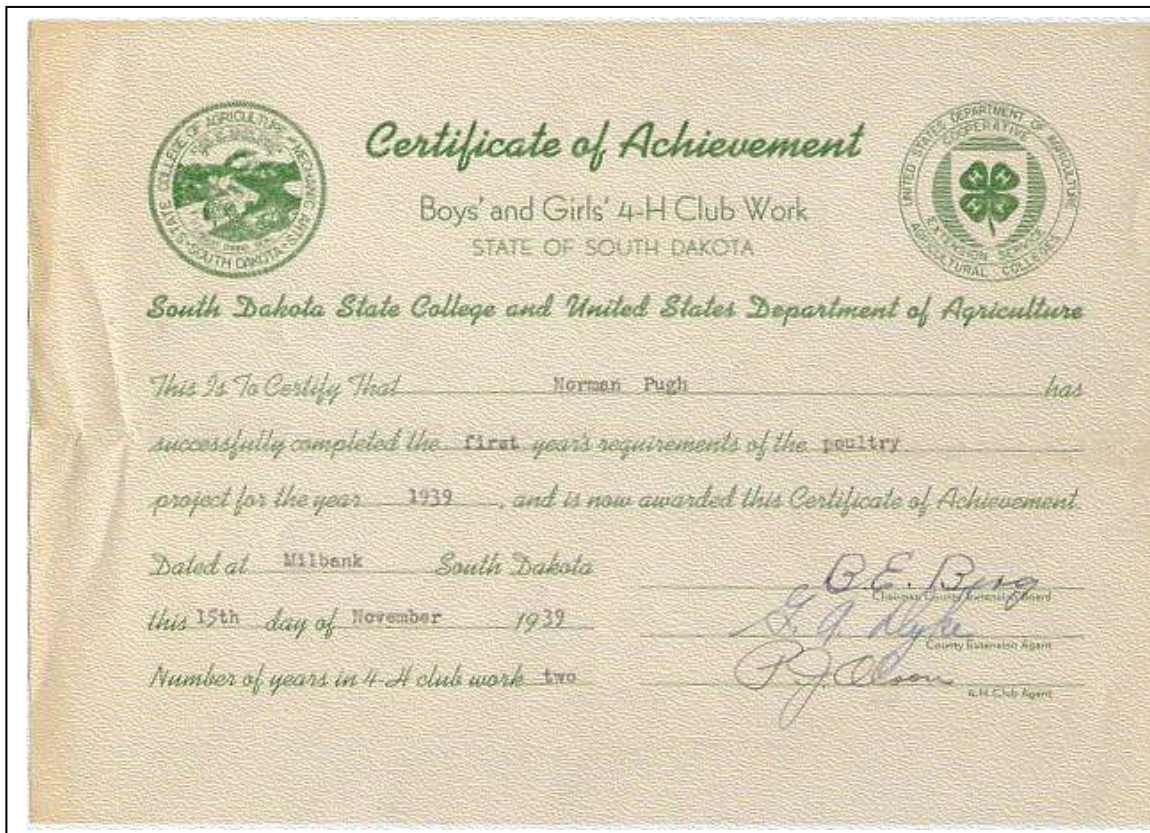

“Ma had ordered a shirt for me from the catalog, I always thought I got the shirt from the mailman, Percy Poor, because he delivered it. It was ordered from Sears and Roebuck or Montgomery Wards, probably; I’m not sure. We didn’t have too many shirts in those days, when you got a shirt you remembered it. That was before DeEll and Gene’s time because there were even leaner days after they were born. I got a shirt from relief and it was the only one I had. I had to take it off as soon as I got home from school and change into my old clothes. On Saturday, Ma would wash it so it would be ready for the next week”.
