**Arthur Pugh** dob app 1801 and Harriet Wallace, Killala COI m 1831 COI  
address Foxford - any family would be born after 1831. Possibly son of  
Edward?

**Maria Pugh**, daughter of Arthur, Gent. married David Baird\*, cabinetmaker  
in 1849. Born 1829. Presbyterian. Most likely daughter of Arthur above  
although she would have been born before they married.

*\*David Baird died age 31, buried in Ballina, 1904. Wife Maria born 1829-1860,  
Son David John 1860-1860 and daughter Margaret Jane 1851-1871. He left as  
beneficiary Hanna Marie Boland, wife of William Boland. He is living with  
William Noland in 1901 census.*

**John Pue** b 1771, died at age of 5- 1776, buried in Bonnifinglass, 5 miles  
from Ballina RC

1827 **Michael Pugh** born to John (dob app 1800) and Eliza Langa/Langan  
Ballina/Kilmormoy RC "baptized by a minister but now in the Catholic  
Church"

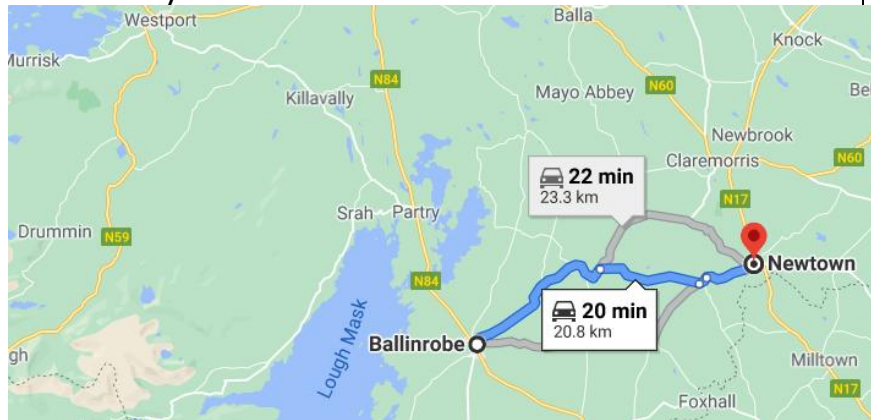
**Honorina Peau** dob app 1840 daughter of Daniel Peau m. Michael Maughan

**Mary Pew 1796-1878- Nailors widow-died in the workhouse age 82 Unk- Sparks?**

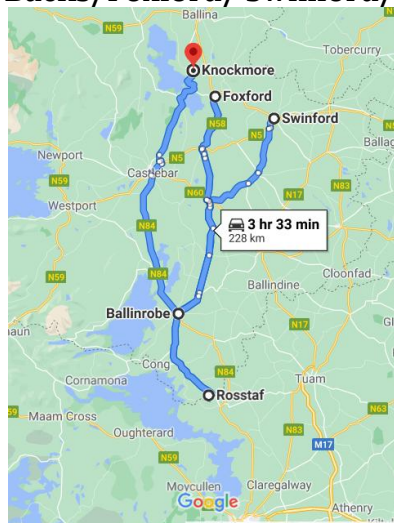
**Patrick Pugh 1786 -1851 age 65- brother of John and son of John and Margaret? COI**

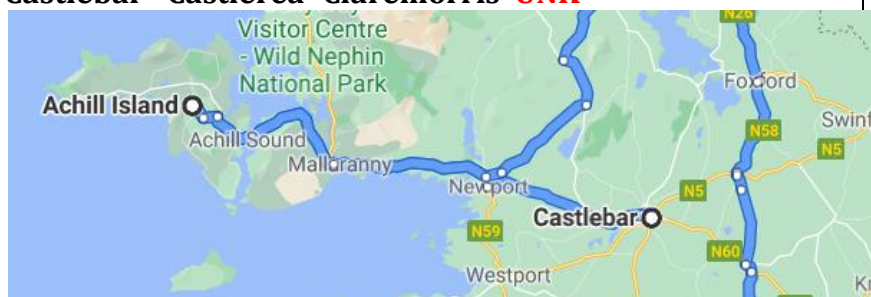

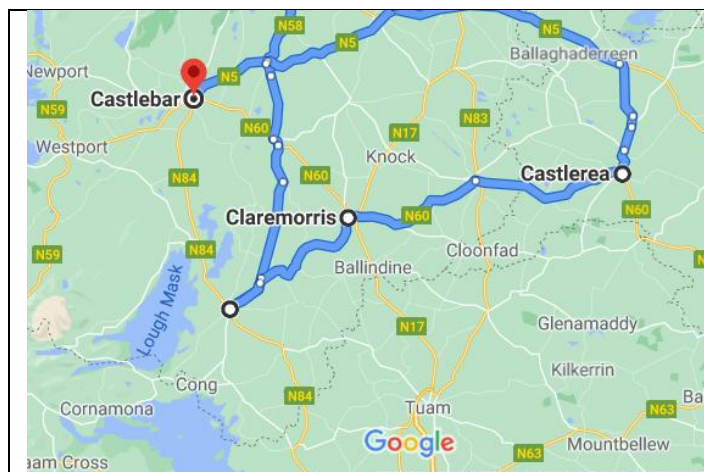



Defendant convicted and ordered to pay five shillings for the costs the sum of one shilling and sixpence and in default of payment to be imprisoned in his Majesty's Prison at <b>Castlebar</b> , in the county of Mayo for seven days without hard labor, unless said sums be sooner paid.
