

Maria Pugh, daughter of Arthur, Gent. married David Baird*, cabinetmaker in 1849. Born 1829. Presbyterian. Most likely daughter of Arthur above although she would have been born before they married.

*David Baird died age 31, buried in Ballina, 1904 . Wife Maria born 1829-1860, Son David John 1860-1860 and daughter Margaret Jane 1851-1871. He left as beneficiary Hanna Marie Boland, wife of William Boland. He is living with William Noland in 1901 census.


John Pue b 1771, died at age of 5- 1776, buried in Bonnifinglass, 5 miles from Ballina RC


